About MacIntyre Wind Farm Precinct

Situated on 36,000 hectares of leased land in South West Queensland, the MacIntyre Wind Farm Precinct is being delivered through a partnership between CleanCo and ACCIONA.

The Precinct will have the capacity to generate up to 102 megawatts of new renewable energy.

CleanCo will build, own and operate its own wind farm of 18 turbines and invest in a further 400 megawatts through a power purchase agreement, contributing up to 500 megawatts of new renewable energy.

Each turbine consists of three blades standing up to 285 metres from the ground to maximum blade tip height. Electricity generated by each turbine is fed into a transmission network.

Underground lines lead to an onsite substation with potential for future energy storage. Electricity will be transmitted into the Queensland electricity network via 64 kilometres of new transmission lines.

Up to 400 jobs will be generated over the life of the Precinct, providing a significant economic boost to regional Queensland communities, with local spend during construction tipped to exceed \$500 million.

Early works are expected to commence from mid-2020, with construction to commence in mid-2021 and the entire MacIntyre Precinct to be operational in 2024.

About CleanCo

CleanCo is Queensland's publicly owned clean energy generator, with a current trading portfolio of 1120 MW in the National Energy Market (NEM).

CleanCo has a target to support 1000 MW of new renewable energy generation by 2025 and will achieve this by building, owning and operating renewable energy projects and by supporting investment in other new renewable energy projects.
